

Cabarrus Homelessness Indicators

July - September 2022

Opportunity House

Registered an average of **33** new clients per month in the third quarter, representing **298** new clients year to date.

AYA House

AYA House has provided beds for **21** unduplicated persons in the 1st quarter, **29** unduplicated persons in the 2nd quarter, and **20** unduplicated persons in the 3rd quarter of 2022.

These residents are reentering our community from incarceration, substance abuse treatment and chronic homelessness.

Cabarrus County Evictions

There were **330** recorded evictions in the third quarter, averaging **110** per month. A total of **689** year to date.

Cooperative Christian Ministry

Received has **488** applications for housing. A total of **1,386** people in housing crisis. At **2.8** per family, likely representing over **600** children.

Cabarrus County and Kannapolis City Schools

Reporting **405** students as homeless during the first three months of the 2022/23 school year. Compared to **220** students at the same period last year.

The Unsheltered Homeless

The unsheltered impact group estimates **300-500** individuals in our community living in tents, cars, etc. An average of **346** people representing an **86%** increase in two years.

Cabarrus County Foster Care Program

The number of youths in foster care is **164** compared to **157** at the same time last year. A total of **six** youth have aged out year to date.

The Open Door House is serving females in this population in Cabarrus County.
